Santander Scholarships

Santander Scholarships helps people improve their employability through lifelong learning, offering grants and free training in professional skills for all ages.

We offer higher education, mobility and research scholarships, among others, as well as free training for adults, of any age, who wish to acquire and refresh their professional skills. And we achieve our goal through programmes created by institutions, universities and organisations that have signed partnership agreements with us.

We also have a wide selection of free educational content to meet the diverse needs of our Santander Scholarship users.















Main Santander Scholarship programmes in 2022

In 2022, we launched more than 1.100 scholarship and training programmes in 11 countries. These were particularly relevant for our communities because of their effect on enhancing their employability.

We have multiple programmes and address different topics, selected according to our users' preferences (languages, technology and skills, for example). All of the calls for applications are available on the Santander Scholarships global online platform.

We open global scholarship and training programmes for applications in 11 countries, while the countries themselves develop specific programmes in line with their communities' needs.

Global scholarship programmes launched this year include Santander Language Scholarships | Online **English Courses** for studying English and improving employability, and Santander Language Scholarships | **UK English Summer Experience**, giving 100 young people the chance to study English in person in the United Kingdom in 2023. Both programmes were launched in collaboration with the British Council.

The 1.000 Santander Sustainability Scholarships | Skills for the Green Transition, run in collaboration with Cambridge Judge Business School, offer knowledge and tools for anyone who would like to play an active role in green initiatives in their work environment or refocus their career.

The XII Santander Women Scholarships | SW50 **Leadership - LSE**, organised in collaboration with the London School of Economics and Political Science, which provide highperformance training to women in senior management roles in companies in any sector. We also held the first Santander SW50 Summit in London, which was attended by more than 200 women and SW50 alumni who are leaders worldwide.

Some of the programmes launched in our countries were of particular interest to local communities

The Santander Scholarship programmes that we have launched in the countries include the more than 3,000 Santander Erasmus Scholarships for university students in 4 countries (Germany, Spain, Poland and Portugal).

Argentina has 500 Santander Scholarships | Full Stack Developer - ITBA Programme, which offer beneficiaries training in programming and in basic skills necessary for their professional development.

Brazil offered two hugely relevant scholarship opportunities in 2022: 64,000 Santander Technology Scholarships | Santander Bootcamp, which strengthen training in software development and 1,600 Santander Scholarships | Santander Graduação, a financial grant to help beneficiaries meet the costs of their academic training.

In Chile more than 400 Santander Scholarships | International Undergraduate Mobility allowed students to study abroad for one academic term. The grant covers registration, travel, insurance, subsistence and accommodation costs.

Spain has more than 700 Santander Studies Scholarships | Progress 2022, which offer 1,000 euros to cover costs for undergraduate and master's degrees.

In México 200 SantanderScholarships | Subsistence Support, were offered, with beneficiaries receiving 200 euros. Portugal has 50 Santander Technology Scholarships Data Analytics and Data Science, with an online programme on Big Data Talent Discovery and Upskilling.

Through Santander Scholarships, and with the support of the European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI), we have launched the Fundación Universia Circular Plan, which facilitates access to specialist digital training. It offers a payment solution where the money returned by a student is used to train others. In 2022, more than 140 people received bootcamp training in digital skills.

Main Santander X projects in 2022

Throughout 2022, we kept supporting entrepreneurship across all stages, with more than 180 programmes.

We support entrepreneurs at every stage of their journey, through global and countryspecific programmes. We offer them resources from their initial stages (Santander X Explorer and Santander X Launch) through to their consolidation on the market. We hold the Santander X awards (national competition where the most promising projects are selected to form part of a global competition), global challenges that look for the most innovative solutions to relevant issues of major relevance for society, and have a global community of the most prominent businesses (Santander X 100).

We have launched new editions of Santander X Explorer, a pre-incubation programme that allows young entrepreneurs from 11 countries to make their innovative

ideas come true, thanks to practical learning methods. In 2022, the programme received over 2,900 project applications from 200 universities.

Santander X Launch, which helps to prepare projects for their release on the market: there were two editions in 2022.

We have launched new editions of Santander X local awards, with submissions accepted in 8 countries and more than 1,900 projects registered; and there was a new edition of the Santander X Global Award





We help people join the labour market by connecting universities, businesses and junior talent.

Our pillars are:

- Accompanying and providing quidance to universities and training centres so that their students can find quality employment.
- Connecting companies with new talent, favouring employability.

In 2022, we facilitated the onboarding of 3,100 professionals to organisations in Spain and Brazil.

At Universia, we use the most advanced technology and the most innovative artificial intelligence (AI) techniques so that we can provide personalised experiences, run efficient selection processes and suggest quality job offers focused on STEAM and diverse talent to our customers and users.

We launched new employability and networking initiatives where we brought together young professionals and HR leaders from the large corporations, offering them the opportunity to connect, solve challenges together and exchange points of view regarding the job market.

We've launched **Universia Metaworking**, a talent competition with more than 2,500 young people signed up to look for a job. This competition lets them measure their ingenuity, strategy and agility when it comes to solving challenges prepared by recruiters and talent hunters from the nine participating companies.

And we've organized **Top Talent**, a programme designed to help companies find talent among young people. More than 80 participants have the opportunity to work as part of a team with the participating companies and interact with people with similar profiles.

Campus Digital

We offer universities a new digital model for interacting with their students.

With a secure digital credential and a mobile app, through a simply, easy-to-use digital experience, processes are made more agile and daily communication with all university groups is personalised.



Brazil, Chile, Spain, Mexico and Portugal

In 2022, we have run workshops in Chile, Mexico and Spain with the participation of universities and students to identify functionalities and improvements we have added to existing academic services (timetables, grades, subjects, notifications and events).

New functionalities include:

- Scholarships and training content: students can access both global and local scholarship programmes and free training content, provided by Santander Scholarships.
- Job offers and work experience placements: especially designed for university students to access directly via the app.
- Exclusive discounts: we provide access to discounts on transport, entertainment, concerts/festivals, cinemas, food, fashion...

In 2022, we also deployed Campus Digital at universities in Brazil, Chile, Mexico and Portugal.

We signed global partnerships with the main manufacturers of digital access control worldwide: Salto Systems and HID.



Fundación Universia

We accelerated the transformation of higher education through communities and we drove diversity, inclusion and equality in educational and workplace environments.

We continued our consolidation as a worldwide point of reference in the area of diversity, equality and inclusion, with active participation in international forums run by the United Nations, International Labour Organisation and UNESCO.

Actions taken in 2022 featured training programmes in digital skills, that we launched using public and private funding, for STEM profiles with a disability.

We launched initiatives such as:

- · CyberSkills, to train 100 people on cybersecurity. An initiative that was backed financially by Incibe as part of the Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan (financed by the European Union's NextGenerationEU Funds).
- JAVA Training Bootcamp Scholarships, in collaboration with Accenture, for students with disabilities. Training in web development with a 90% employability success rate.
- Digital Reskilling Scholarships, launched in collaboration with Indra and The Bridge, to drive training in full stack web development for people with disabilities and STEM training to strengthen their employability.

MetaRed

Main collaborative network for highereducation institutions in Latin America and a space for universities to reflect on digital transformation, university entrepreneurship and sustainability.

We worked on three of the main challenges for Latin American higher-education institutions.

- · Digital Transformation: MetaRed TIC, with IT managers, to share best practices and success stories and support the digital transformation. Formed by 798 universities.
- · Strengthening entrepreneurship: MetaRed X, with entrepreneurship offices of 398 universities to boost startup collaboration, provide them with tools and share best practices.

 Driving Social Responsibility and Ethical Governance: MetaRed ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance), new network launched in 2022 with 7 universities and highereducation institutions that want to implement ESG criteria.

The various actions we carried out this year saw the participation of more than 6,500 university leaders and managers and we have trained more than 4,000 members of university management committees (3,466 MetaRed TIC and 603 MetaRed X).

All of these actions have been designed by the more than 100 inter-university collaborative workgroups.
