

## SETTING UP AUTOMATIC UPDATES

Making sure devices, apps and software are up to date means that the latest security patches will be installed and ready to protect any information stored within.

Sometimes automatic updates are not available. Make sure to put a regular reminder in, to check those manually.



### Windows

1. Press the Windows button or open the Start Menu
2. Open Settings
3. Click on Update & Security
4. Click on " Windows Update ", check updates are not paused

Windows 10 has automatic updates by default, you can choose your preferred hours for updates to occur (e.g. outside of business hours)

### Mac

1. Open the Apple menu
2. Select System Preferences
3. Click on Software Update
4. Choose "Automatically keep my Mac up to date"

### Android

1. Most system updates occur automatically, but make sure it's the same for apps
2. Open the Google Play Store
3. Choose Settings in the menu
4. Under General, select "Auto-update apps"

### iOS

1. Open Settings
2. Scroll down to General
3. Select Software Update
4. Select " Automatic Updates ", make sure both options are green
